Saint of the Day: Saint Heribert

Heribert was born in Worms and he was the son of Hugo, count of Worms. He was educated in the school of Worms Cathedral and at the Benedictine Gorze Abbey in Lorraine, France. He returned to Worms Cathedral to be provost and was ordained a priest in 994.

In the same year, Otto III appointed him chancellor for Italy, and four years later, for Germany as well, a position which he held until Otto's death on January 23, 1002. Heribert was made archbishop of Cologne in 998. Then, he also served Emperor St. Henry.

Heribert built the monastery of Deutz, on the Rhine, and performed miracles, including ending a drought. He is thus invoked for rains. He died in Cologne on March 16, 1021 and was buried at Deutz.
